SAFETY

1. VEHICLES

- a) Vehicle safety orders obligatory from the year 2000.
- b) Vehicle drivers to be competent.
- c) Only one driver to be allowed in the cab of a tractor.
- d) Only the driver, plus one other person to travel on the float to and from each procession.
- e) No person to be allowed to ride on draw bars.
- f) Each float to be fitted at both front and back with a lighting unit which indicates to all other traffic the exact width of moving floats.
- g) Insurance should be discussed with your agent. You may find it possible to insure for all carnivals at a special rate.

2. FLOATS

- a) All floats must be accompanied by walking marshals.
- b) All people riding on floats should be secured and kept at a safe distance from the sides.
- c) No-one to be allowed to sit on a float with their legs dangling over the side.
- d) Floats with young people should be accompanied by adults.

3. WALKING ENTRIES

- a) Do not get too close to any vehicle, either in front or behind. Concentrate on what is going on.

GENERAL RULES

1. All floats are restricted to 15 feet in height (from ground level).
2. NO water must be directed at spectators from any float.
3. There must be three entries in a class to constitute less than three, a prize will be awarded at the discretion of the Judges.
4. All entrants who take part do so at their own risk.
5. The committee reserve the right to refuse entry. No entries accepted without an entry form.
6. Entrants in classes **E,F,G,H,J,K,L, M** must be motorised. Entrants in classes **A,B,C,D** must **not** be motorised.
7. All entrants must complete the entire route.

1. The procession will form up on the Esplanade, east of Beach Road, facing east from 4pm onwards.
2. The Esplanade will be closed from 12 noon; all vehicles still on the Esplanade by 3pm will be removed.
3. All entrants **A-M** may enter the Esplanade via FISHERMANS GAP, (CARPET RIGHT), or BEACH ROAD.
4. Entrants in class **H** must enter the Esplanade via CARPET RIGHT, after 6pm (BUT BEFORE 7PM) and form up West of Beach Road.
5. Entrants IN CLASSES **E-M** may line up in any order, on the right hand side of the road (the "sea" side)
6. Entrants in classes **A-D** will line up in Trevelyan Road. **NO** vehicles may park on the left hand side of the Esplanade. Cars bringing personnel for the floats will need to park in the car park. However, passes will be given to two cars per float so they may park in the compound at Riverside Way.
7. **All** entrants must collect their class entry forms from a Marshall at the top of **Beach Road** by 7pm.
8. Personnel need to be on their carts by **7pm**. Judges will visit all entrants to familiarise themselves with the entry.
9. At 8:00pm the procession will move off.
10. The route will be: Trevelyan Road, Harbour Road, Underfleet, Fore Street, Marine Place, Esplanade.
11. Disperse along East Walk. Please remain in character until you reach Beach Road.
12. Cups and certificates will be presented by the Queen in the Town Hall from 10pm. **NOT ON THE ESPLANADE**
13. Music and light refreshments provided in the Town Hall for all persons taking part in the procession. The bar will be open to sell drinks until 11pm.
14. Any money won will be sent by post within two weeks.
